1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience, and provide information to website owners.

Cookies can be:

- Essential – required for the website to function
- Analytics – help us understand how visitors use the site
- Functional – remember your preferences
- Marketing/Tracking – used for advertising or behavioural tracking

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

- Ensure the website functions correctly
- Improve performance and user experience
- Analyse traffic and usage patterns
- Remember your cookie preferences
- Protect the website from malicious activity

We do not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information without your consent.

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Essential Cookies (Strictly Necessary)

These cookies enable core website functionality such as security, page navigation, and form submissions. The website cannot function properly without them.

Examples include:

- Session cookies
- Security/authentication cookies
- Cookie consent preferences

Analytics & Performance Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the website, allowing us to improve content and usability.

Examples:

- Wix analytics cookies
- Google Analytics (if enabled)

These may collect:

- Page views
- Time spent on pages
- Device/browser information
- Navigation paths

Functional Cookies

These cookies remember your preferences to enhance your experience.

Examples:

- Language settings
- Form autofill preferences

Marketing/Advertising Cookies (If Enabled)

If you choose to enable marketing tools (e.g., Meta Pixel, Google Ads), these cookies may track browsing behaviour across websites to deliver relevant ads.

If you do not enable these tools, no marketing cookies will be used.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Our website may use cookies from trusted third parties, including:

- Wix (website hosting and analytics)
- Google Analytics
- Microsoft services (if embedded content is used)
- Social media platforms (if you interact with embedded icons or share buttons)

These providers may set their own cookies according to their privacy policies.

5. Managing Cookies

When you first visit our website, you will see a cookie banner allowing you to:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies
- Manage your preferences

You can also control cookies through your browser settings:

- Block cookies
- Delete existing cookies
- Set preferences for specific websites
